

Major Changes to WPLA Rules

Items marked with an * were added or changed based on member feedback

1. Consistent with new Declaration Restrictions

- Clarified restriction on internal combustion engines: "Internal combustion engines must be trimmed upward and shall not be started or operated on the Lake." *
- Clarified gate keys shall not be duplicated or loaned to any non-member *
- Added rule against blowing leaves and other yard debris into the Lake or ditches/water courses that feed the Lake *
- Clarified that persons using the boat launch area must clean up after themselves *
- Clarified restriction on loud music and foul language applies when on the Lake or at the boat launch area *

2. Adds provisions for addressing violations

- Violation Charges of \$50 for a single occurrence, \$10 per day for a maximum 90 days for continuing violation
- Member's right to use the lake can be suspended for repeat violations or failure to pay violation charges *
- Appeal procedure revised to better protect member rights *
- Memorandum of Understanding can be used to grandfather existing violations, but not required
